

Digital Noticeboard

What is it?

The Digital Noticeboard is a central hub for residents, displaying site-specific info, news, and local weather on a large wall-mounted screen ideal for communal areas. Content is also accessible remotely via tablet or smartphone, with no app required.

Who is it for?

The Digital Noticeboard gives housing providers an effective and easy-to-use way to share important information with residents. It can display a wide range of content, from local weather updates and community news to scheme-specific details like social events or contact information.

By keeping residents informed and engaged, the Noticeboard supports social inclusion and strengthens the connection between housing schemes and their wider communities.

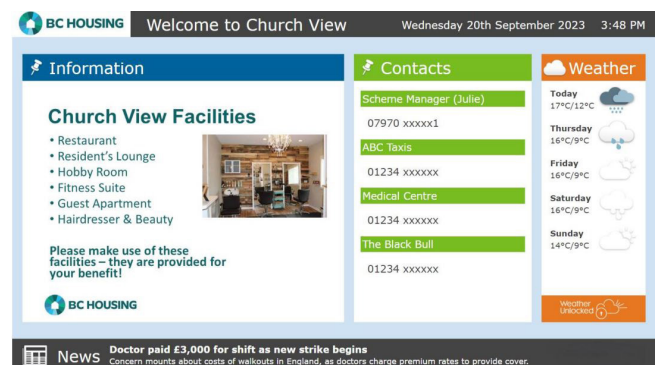
How does it work?

The Digital Noticeboard is a 43" wall-mounted monitor powered by the NB Player; a compact, internet-connected PC mounted behind the screen and linked via HDMI.

Staff create and manage bespoke content through a secure web portal, which is displayed alongside feeds from internet sources like BBC News. Up to 20 slides can be shown: 10 site-specific and 10 organisation-wide.

What does it show?

Position	Content	Detail
Top	Welcome	Provider logo and site specific welcome message. Also shows accurate time and date.
Bottom	News	Rolling news feed sourced from BBC News
Left	Information	Rotating 'carousel' of five images with content supplied and managed by provider.
Centre	Contacts	Useful contact information such as scheme manager, local taxi services or medical centres.
Right	Weather	Graphical representation of weather forecast over next 5 days with maximum daytime and minimum night time temperatures.

Technical details

Connection to the Internet (Ethernet or Wi-Fi with a minimum download speed of 2Mbps/s) and a suitable mains supply (dual 13A socket) is required. Ethernet and mains connections must be within 1m of the Noticeboard location.
